CONNOISSEUR'S CHOICE

The Coravin System is unique in that it enables us to serve incredible wines by the glass without pulling the cork. Preserving the natural ageing process and leaving the wine in perfect condition. The non-coring needle gently passes through corks without displacing cork material. Once the needle is removed, the cork simply expands back to its normal shape. As wine is extracted through the needle, it is replaced with pure Argon gas, ensuring oxygen never touches the remaining wine, keeping it as fresh as the day it was bottled.

MAVERICKS

The word "maverick" comes from Samuel Maverick, a Texas cattle rancher in the 1800s who refused to brand his cattle. This was unorthodox at the time and led to people calling unbranded cattle "mavericks" – and calling people who don't follow the rules "mavericks," too. The same can be said about the wine from this section, carefully selected, unorthodox and from the far corners of the world, that we encourage you give a go.

Rkatsiteli, Vachnadziani, Georgia 2022.....29

Some of the world's oldest grape varieties are found in Georgia of which the country's wine producers are fiercely proud. This bright and lively white is made from Rkatsiteli (pronounced 'Ree-katsy-telly'), a grape that's capable of retaining a good crisp acidity despite the hot summer temperatures that can be reached in the eastern region of Kakheti .

Furmint Sauska, Tokaji, Hungary 202112 / 23 / 46

One of the world's lesser-known noble grapes. Tending not to court the limelight, it usually hides behind the name of Tokaji – the ancient and famous lusciously sweet Hungarian wine of which it is the principle grape. However it is also delicious when vinified dry. With acidity levels which can preserve it for decades giving complex flavours of fresh peach, and lemon zest with a salty minerality.

Albariño 'Organistrum', Martín Códax, Rías Baixas, Spain 2020.....62

From the famous wine region of Rías Baixas in Galicia, Spain and made with 100 % Albariño grapes, it boasts a bright and fresh taste that is marked by notes of ripe fruit, citrus, and a subtle minerality. Although after fermentation, the wine ages for four months in French oak barrels making Organistrum the only oaked Albarino from Martín Códax in the region.

RED

Juggernaut Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, California 2020.....19 / 37 / 73

Juggernaut grapes are grown in challenging conditions, where true grit and determination yield spectacular results. The vines are battered by wind and fog, with a real struggle to utilize every precious hour of warmth and sunlight over the long growing season.

Overcoming challenges builds character and this struggle comes with great reward, giving the wine a balance of intensity and unrelenting flavours of red cherry, spice and floral notes.

Langhe Nebbiolo, La Spinetta, Piedmont, Italy 202185

Produced from the same grape as Italy's biggest hitting red wine Barolo, this wine is a true expression of the characteristic flavours of the Langhe region, featuring a bright ruby-red colour with elegant aromas of red fruits, violet, and herbs. With a medium-body and a complex structure, La Spinetta Langhe Nebbiolo is a must-try for seekers of a rich and flavourful Italian wine.

Syrah, Chateau Oumsiyat, Mount Lebanon 2020.....39

Château Oumsiyat is a modern winery in the village of Mtein, Lebanon. With four generations of the Bou Sleiman family, this has allowed for a unique fusion of both old world and new world influences within the wine. The grapes are grown at over 1,000 metres elevation between Mount Lebanon to the west and the Lebanon Mountains to the east. The altitude, microclimate and soils combine in this ancient terroir to produce fresh wines with a very Mediterranean "feel", complimented with a unique texture and concentration of black fruits.

Not Your Grandma's Chillable Red, Chaffey Bros*, Barossa, Australia 202149

Daniel Chaffey Hartwig and brother in law Theo Engela, the "Chaffey bros", craft their wines from epic low-yielding vineyards nestled among the pristine Barossa and Eden valleys. They are reinterpreting the wines that made the region famous whilst exploring special vineyards and varieties, like this chillable handpicked old vine Barossa Grenache and Mourvèdre blend where the grapes are hand-crafted with minimal intervention.
